SCARF REGISTRATION AND REGULATIONS

- (a) <u>New Group Scarf Registration:</u> Registration will <u>only</u> be effected AFTER the Group has been registered at State Office. Applications from Groups must have the Region Commissioner's recommendation for the Chief Commissioner's approval. On the certification of the Region Commissioner, that a proposed but not yet registered Group (Section) is functioning in a satisfactory preliminary state, scarves can be ordered and will be manufactured. The Group is responsible for the cost of the scarves, when manufactured.
- (b) <u>Change of Existing Scarf Colours and/or Scarf's Description for Registered Groups</u>: Can be done only with Region recommendation and the Chief Commissioner's approval.
- (c) <u>Base Colours</u>: For both Base and Bands, must be Red, Maroon, Black, White, Emerald Green, Bottle Green, Royal Blue, Sky Blue, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey, Yellow, Gold, Purple, Orange, Lime, Saxe (dark Sky Blue). These, and only these, colours will be accepted for registration.
- (d) <u>For Scottish Groups</u>: There are different tartans registered for existing Groups only. No new registrations will be considered.
- (e) <u>Exceptions:</u> Groups already registered with special type scarves may retain same.
- (f) <u>Combinations:</u> Plain scarf, or with one, two or three coloured Bands. Where there is a space between the extreme edge of the scarf and Band 1 this is called the Border and will always be the Base colour. Bands must consist of any of the Base colours.
- (g) <u>The width of the Band(s) or Border</u>: MUST be 6 mm or 12 mm wide.
- (h) <u>Bands</u>: Can be placed:
 - (1) on the extreme edge, or
 - (2) 6 mm from scarf edge, or
 - (3) 12 mm from scarf edge
- (i) The Distance (Spaces) between Bands or between Border and Band: MUST be:
 - (1) no distance at all (joined together), or
 - (2) 6 mm (FOR TWO OR THREE BANDS), or
 - (3) 12 mm (FOR TWO BANDS ONLY)

Spaces are of the Base colour

- (j) A cord can be of a single colour or of two different coloured strands which may be used on the extreme edge of the scarf. Availability of cord colours may be restricted. Enquire at your Snowgum store.
- (k) It is desirable that no two Groups in the same Region wear the same scarf.
- (1) Scarves must not be manufactured before receiving this form back from State Office approved.
