



## SCOUTS AUSTRALIA NSW SCREEN CAPTURE TOUR HOW TO ACCESS STATE FORMS

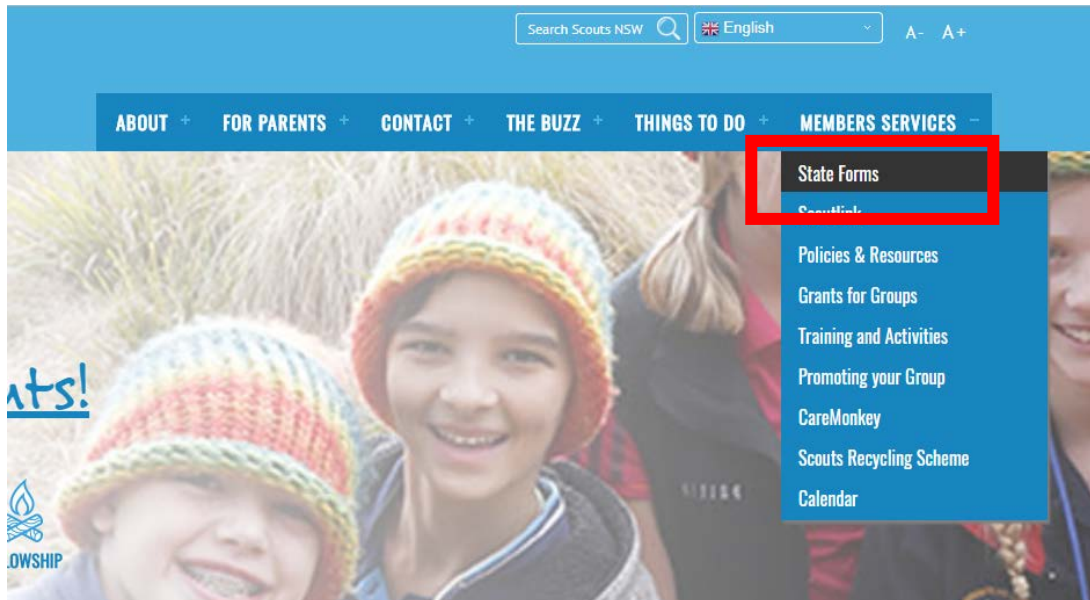

2. Hover over the “Members Services” heading in the main menu.

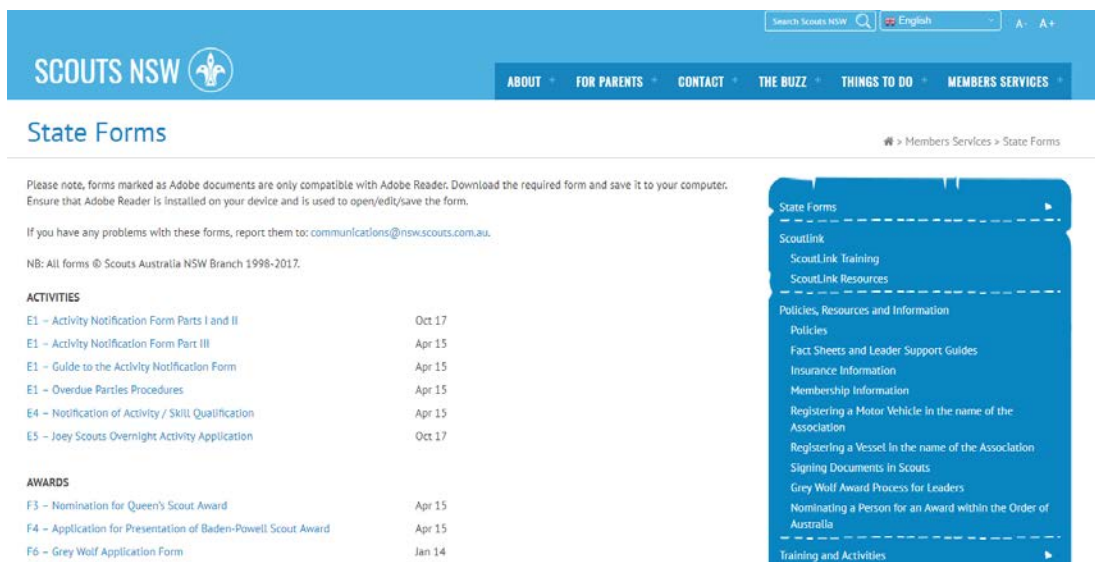
