Scouts NSW Cub Scout Challenge 2021 Scouts Scouts

The purpose of the **Scouts NSW Cub Scout Challenge 2021**, is to encourage all Cub Scouts in NSW to challenge themselves by participating, assisting and leading in nine (9) different adventurous, challenging, fun and inclusive activities between **1 February 2021** and **1 October 2021**.

To complete the Scouts NSW Cub Scout Challenge 2021, each Cub can complete any of the 9 Challenges as a Unit, a Patrol or individually. Each activity completed can only count towards one of the 9 Challenges (e.g. If you go on a camp and complete many different activities, the camp can only be counted towards 1 challenge).

Cub Units should follow the Plan>Do>Review process, by first 'planning' the activity, then 'doing' the activity and finally 'reviewing' the activity.

Allowances should be made for covid-safe activities (e.g. have a camp out in your back yard and get together online to share the experience).

Below is an outline of the Challenges required.



Outdoor (Adventurous)

Complete 2 Outdoor Activities. These could include: *hikes (day or overnight), *camps (could be in own back yard), *bush art, *fishing, *campfire cooking, *fire making, *indigenous bush skills *navigation, *birdwatching, *abseiling, *rock climbing, *sailing, *canoeing, *skiing



Personal Growth (Challenging)

Complete 2 Personal Growth Activities. These could include: *natural art, *write a book, *navigation, *learn about another culture, *care for the local environment, *learn sign language, *care for an animal over a period of time,



Creative (Fun)

Complete 2 Creative Activities. These could include: *bush art, *cooking, *perform at a nursing home, *illustrate a book, *learn to paint, *build something out of wood, *make something out of plaster, *make something by knitting or crocheting, *learn an instrument



Community
(Inclusive)

Complete 2 Community Activities. These could include: *learn about a different culture/community, *clean up Australia day *visit a fire station/SES/police/ambulance, *visit a nursing home, *visit Ronald McDonald House *become pen-pals with Scouts in another country



Complete 1 Additional Challenge. This should be something that your Unit has never done before and can be from any of the Challenge areas. It could include: *learn sign language, *learn a new language, *build a working robot, *take care of a pet, *introduce a friend Cubs
