Funds for Scout Hall work

CAMDEN Haven Scout Hall is set for an upgrade after being allocated \$28,000 in funding by the state.

The hall will be repainted, have its storeroom relined, awning replaced and asbestos building materials safely removed as part of the Government's COVID-19 stimulus program for pro-

jects at Scouts facilities on Crown land.

Member for Port Macquarie, Leslie Williams said: "Scouts NSW is one of our state's largest and most popular youth organisations that helps communities build leadership skills, resilience and friendship through healthy activities for young

people, so it's great to support them."

"Scouting has been operating in Australia since 1908 and this funding will help ensure a range of Scout NSW facilities are in good shape for future generations.

"[Funding of] \$28,000 will be provided to Camden Haven Scout Hall to repaint the

hall, reline the storeroom, replace an awning and safely remove some asbestos building materials."

Scouts NSW chief commissioner Neville Tomkins OAM said the stimulus funds would improve Scout facilities and help attract more members.
