'What Activities Can I Run?'

This document guides Leaders on the **Adventurous Activities** (**AA**) they can run. It considers the conditions, participant competence and leader qualifications and experience. The matrices indicate the supervision methods allowed. Also included is the approver for such an activity which is encoded in the **Activity Notification System** (**ANS**). The matrices guide an **AA Leader** in planning their activity. A modification of the matrices is possible, based on a risk assessment, with the approval of a **Regional Commissioner (Activities)**.

Where this is especially important is party competence. Whilst the guided *Participant Competence* might be OAS Stage 4 and above, building a party that includes some Stage 3 participants may be permissible. If so, consider including some Stage 5 participants who have the additional skills required to support the Stage 3 participants.

If the activity planned aims to build skills along the OAS pathway, and the **AA Leader** has higher skills than that in the matrix and participant ratios are low it may be possible to have Youth with lower capability in the party. In all cases, carry out a risk assessment and discuss it with the nominated approver.

The **AA Leader** may look to other methods to gauge participant competence where a new Youth member has not recorded OAS progression. Such methods may include age and section but should always be backed up by a discussion with the participants to understand their capabilities.

Where a Youth party is under **Indirect Supervision**, consideration of first aid skills is critical. At least two participants must hold a first aid qualification. Likewise, as part of risk assessment, consider whether essential rescue skills (for example, deep water rescue) are mastered and ensure these skills are in the party in the appropriate quantity.

Some activities may require a combination of disciplines. For example, a bushwalk into a remote canyon must comply with the Bushwalking and Canyoning matrices.

Discipline Procedures include considerable detail on how to conduct AA safely and should be referenced with these matrices.

The matrices are designed for the delivery of **AA** to Youth Sections. The **AA Leader** must ensure attending adults have adequate competence.

Several activities allow for the carriage of non-active participants or passengers. These participants are not subject to the Minimum Participant Qualification requirement.

Qualifications are indicated using the *NAAF*. The following mapping guideline is provided To assist leaders who qualified under the old framework during the transition to the current framework:

- 'Scouting Adventure' is generally equivalent to the 'BOS.'
- Safe Participant is generally equivalent to L1
- Trained Participant is generally equivalent to L2 or L3
- Guide remains Guide

To run any **AA**, the **AA** Leader must be an adult member who has completed Scouting Adventure and has a minimum of a Certificate of Adult Appointment. Alternatively, they may be a Rover where the activity is a Rover-only activity.

The following mapping is provided to help with mapping OAS to Adult qualifications:

- OAS Stage 1 to 4 generally maps to Novice to Safe Participant
- OAS Stage 4 to 6 generally maps to Trained Participant
- OAS Stage 5 to 9 maps variously to Assistant Guide and Guide

A Guide holding guide qualifications that match the activity conditions may self-approve an activity where the approver is the Formation Leader (often the Group Leader). Where this occurs, the Guide must notify the Formation Leader.

All approvals and notifications must be obtained and approved through **ANS**.

Document Control:

This document is provided for the Adventurous Activities Hub and is an Appendix to Pro75 Core Conduct Procedure which may be helpful for someone navigating the website. Variations may exist between Pro75 Core Conduct Procedure and this document as improvements and changes are implemented. This document is the definitive guide.
